The Task of the Congregational Safeguarding Commission

- Acts as the advisory board for the superior general in the matters concerning safeguarding minors and vulnerable persons.
- Draft the safeguarding policy.
- Promote the culture of care and dignity in the congregation.
- Prepare the profile of commission members.
- Ensure that the Church's mandate in safeguarding minors is implemented.
- Implement the objectives of the safeguarding policy.
- Guide the province/regional safeguarding commissions.
- Conduct workshops on the issues of safeguarding at international level.
- Ensure that every member of the Congregation and associates follow the safeguarding protocols.
- Advice provinces/region in investigating the reports on receiving the accusations.
- Promote the Church's safeguarding message.
- Prepare e-learning programs at international level.
- Keep the members informed through media communication and update website.
- Maintain records with confidentiality.
- Deal with accounting and finances related to safeguarding commission.
- Evaluate and review the annual reports of the provinces, region and mission stations.

The term of the commission is for three years.

Task of PSC/RSC

- Acts as the advisory board for the provincial/regional superior in the matters concerning safeguarding minors and vulnerable persons.
- Draft the safeguarding policy for province/region.
- Promote the culture of care and dignity in our communities and institutions.
- Prepare the profile of commission members.



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- Address the safeguarding issues in the province/region.
 - Create a redressal mechanism with penalties based on ecclesial and civil laws.
 - Implement the objectives of the safeguarding policy.
 - Guide the Unit safeguarding coordinators.
 - Conduct workshops on the issues of safeguarding in institutions.
 - Train all our sisters and staff to follow the safeguarding protocols.
 - Address the legal issues when necessary.
 - Provide accompaniment for the victims and their families.
 - Investigate the reports on receiving the accusations.
 - Promote the Church's safeguarding message.
 - Keep the members informed through media communication.
 - Maintain records with confidentiality.
 - Monitor and minister to the accused.
 - Deal with accounting and finances related to safeguarding commission.
 - Submit the annual report to the Province.

The term of the commission is for three years.
